

WHAT STATE FINANCIAL SUPPORT IS AVAILABLE FOR THE RECRUITMENT OF VULNERABLE MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC?

Socio-occupational reintegration programme

Organic Law 1/2004, of 28 December, on Comprehensive Protection Measures against Gender Violence, provides victims of gender violence with comprehensive and multidisciplinary care, which includes, among other measures, those aimed at unemployed victims registered with the public employment services. These measures are intended to favour their socio-occupational integration which, in turn, will provide them with economic and personal independence that will allow them to break the link with their aggressor. In compliance with this precept, Royal Decree 1917/2008, of 21 November, which approves the programme of socio-occupational integration for women victims of gender violence, provides that these women, when they are registered as job seekers, may be beneficiaries of this programme of socio-occupational integration.
